Farrant (ca.1525-1580) Lord for thy tender mercy's sake

Byrd Ave Verum

Gibbons (1583-1625) Almighty and Everlasting God

Tomkins (1572-1656) Ye children who do serve the Lord

Gregorian Chant Salve Regina (Solemn).
